## **Frühroter Veltliner**

Synonym. Malvasier

### *The Origin*

The Frührote Veltliner is a crossing of Roter Veltliner and Silvaner. This white vine is newly planted very rarely in Austria.

### *Character of the vine*

The Frührote Veltliner grows best on poor, stony soil. Fertile soil is not useful for cultivation. The vines are frost-sensitive, so this early-maturing variety of wine is mostly harvested in mid-september.

### The wine

The Malvasier does not have a typical bouquet and is a low in acid and mild wine with masses of extract. Because of his early-maturing nature, this wine is often the first in the new vintage and fancied for his juvenile-light freshness.
