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## **St. Laurent**

### *Origin*

St. Laurent is a seedling (breed out of a seed) of the variety blue Burgundy. He has its origin in France (Elsass), the exact origin is unknown.

The name St. Laurent applies to the 10th of August, the day of „Saint Lawrence“. At this day the grapes usually start to get physiologically matured and to turn color.

### *Character*

St. Laurent loves light chalky soils and his physiological maturity is early. The Vine is sensitive against late frost and during the blossom against rainy weather. Harvest time of St. Laurent is at the beginning of October.

### *Wine*

St. Laurent counts in the international comparison undoubtedly to the high quality class. He has a powerful, deep red color and owns a fine fruity burgundy-bouquet, which is reminiscent of sour cherries. As a young wine he has a lot of tan and acidity, therefore he need some time to mature. St. Laurent is a long-lasting red wine with mostly a high alcoholic-content and a high extract content.
