The Origin

It is generally known, that all the sorts of Burgundy have their roots in the blue Burgundy (Pinot Noir). His habitat is Burgundy in France, where the vine is documented since the 14th century.

The character of the vine

The Pinot Blanc has special requirements to the soil and site. The grapes need high maturity to produce qualitatively appealing wine. Ideal are nutritious soils and warm sites. The Pinot Blanc matures middle-late and is harvested early to mid-October.

The wine

The Pinot Blanc has no typical bouquet for he is often mildly in his flavour. With middle alcohol concentration, the variety mostly shows a more or less clear walnut and almond note at the palate. At the appropriate maturity of the grapes, the wine shows an astonishing full body and noble character, which makes him a universal dinner wine.
